The middle school faculty will supervise the event and will expect students to dress modestly. The following should guide you in planning and shopping for this event.

- When choosing attire, please keep in mind that this is a special event. Suits and ties for the gentlemen and dresses for the ladies are strongly encouraged.
- Jeans and athletic attire will not be permitted.
- Attire for the ladies should be appropriate in length.
- Strapless dresses are not permitted, nor should dresses have cut-outs at the waist, mid-section, or back. Backless dresses are not permitted.
- Plunging necklines and dresses with sheer or see-through material will not be permitted.
- Full-length prom-type gowns are discouraged.

Additional information:

- Parents, please remember that unless you have signed up to volunteer, the Eighth Grade Dance will remain a drop-off event.
- Students are expected to remain in compliance with the dress code throughout the course of the event. If a student is determined to be out of compliance, clothing will be accessorized to conform to the dress code.
- “Dates” are not allowed. We encourage students to focus on having fun with all of their friends and classmates.
- This dance is for Mount Paran Christian School eighth-graders only. Students from other grades/schools may not attend.
- We ask that all students remain for the duration of the dance. If your child must leave early, he or she will need to be checked out by an adult.
- Because this is a school-sponsored event, school rules and expectation will remain in effect.
