

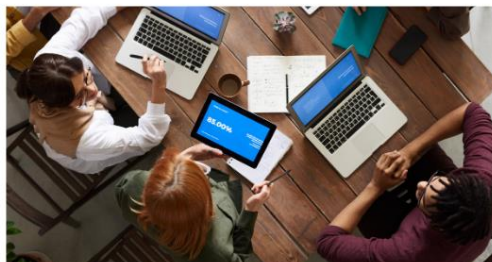

TIME to Honor WWII Cadet Nurse Corps

Join GFWC in urging Congress to enact the **U.S. Cadet Nurse Corps Service Recognition Act (H.R. 6203, S. 3329)** to give long overdue federal recognition to the more than 124,000 remarkable women who answered the call to serve during WWII, providing critical support to our nation's health care system under the strain of war. This bipartisan federal legislation would recognize former Cadet Nurses' service to the country and provide them with honorary veterans' status, honorable discharges, a service medal, a burial plaque or grave marker, and other well-deserved commendations. Recognizing them with honorary veteran status provides a well-deserved tribute to their legacy, sacrifice, and patriotism.

GFWC Federal Legislative Priorities March 2026 In Brief:

- 1) **VAWA** (Violence Against Women Act) Appropriations
- 2) **Victims of Crime Act (VOCA)** funding
- 3) **Anti-Trafficking**
- 4) **Online Safety** – GFWC Legislative Alerts have supported the bipartisan **Kids Online Safety Act (KOSA)** and the **GUARD Act** to prevent online exploitation of children.
- 5) **National Endowment of the Arts (NEA)**
- 6) **Older Americans Act and Farm Bill** – GFWC urges Congress to reauthorize these to restore and protect funding and to strengthen programs addressing hunger and food insecurity.
- 7) **Education & Libraries (STEAM)** – GFWC supports federal funding for STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math) programs; and increased funding for the **Institute of Museums and Library Services** to strengthen local community resources.
- 8) **Environment** – GFWC urges Congress to continue funding the National Park's **Legacy Restoration Fund**, the **Land and Water Conservation Fund**, and the **America the Beautiful Act**.
- 9) **Global Vaccinations – Shot@life**
- 10) **Alzheimer's and Dementia**
- 11) **Breast Cancer Screening – Find it Early Act (HR 6182, S 1410)**
