

## **INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A SURVEY CONDUCTED BY THE BANFF WORKING GROUP ON ANTIBODY MEDIATED INJURY**

The Antibody-Mediated Injury Working Group of the Banff Foundation on Allograft Pathology invites you to participate in a Multidisciplinary Transplant Conference Questionnaire. The care of transplant recipients is complex, requiring a collaborative and multi-disciplinary effort. This research study entails the coordination of the responses of healthcare professionals from a range of disciplines to deliver comprehensive care that addresses the transplant recipient's medical, behavioral, and psychosocial needs. Despite the evidence supporting the benefit of a multidisciplinary approach in transplantation, very little is known regarding the actual proportion of transplant centers practicing regular, comprehensive, multidisciplinary transplant conferences.

To better understand the current practice and perceived value of multidisciplinary perspectives in the diagnosis and management of transplant patients at risk for immune-mediated injuries, we are seeking responses from transplant professionals worldwide to a brief 10-minute survey. Participation in this research study is voluntary, and your responses will be collated and analyzed anonymously. A manuscript will be prepared to summarize our findings, and submitted for publication.
