Board Member - 3-year term – Board members function as part of the governing body responsible for accomplishing the objectives of the Society. The Board members' responsibilities include direct oversight of their assigned committee(s) and they shall regularly report to the Board of Directors on activities undertaken by the committees. Board members shall have a minimum of three years' experience in the field of histocompatibility and immunogenetics. In addition, all candidates for Board membership must have demonstrated at least three years of commitment to forwarding the Society's strategic goals.
