



2023 Call for ASHI Board Nominations

Completed form must be received at ASHI Headquarters by **April 14, 2023**

The ASHI Leadership Development Committee encourages ASHI members to nominate candidates for all available board positions. The Leadership Development Committee will prepare a slate of candidates, which will be forwarded to the ASHI membership no later than 30 days prior to the submission deadline. If there are candidates you feel would be an asset to the ASHI Board of Directors, please complete and submit this nomination form. All nominations must be accompanied by the signatures/email from at least 10 full or honorary members in good standing.

President-elect - Three-year commitment (one year as President-elect, one year as President and one year as Past President) - The President-elect shall assist the President and Vice President of Operations as necessary in the general operations of the Society and oversight of the Board of Directors. This individual shall hold an earned doctoral degree, have a minimum of five years' experience in the field of histocompatibility and immunogenetics and have served on the Board of Directors for a minimum of one year. The term is for one year, whereupon, this person shall become the President.

President-elect Candidate: _____

Vice-President of Operations - Three-year commitment - The Vice-President of Operations assists the President in the general operations of the society and in providing direct oversight to the Board of Directors. S/he works directly with the President to facilitate planning and development and, in concert with the President and the Board of Directors, establishes the strategic objectives of the Society. The Vice-President of Operations is responsible for adherence to, and efficient timely accomplishment of, the goals and objectives set out by the Society's strategic plan. This shall be an individual who does not hold an earned doctoral level degree and has a minimum of five years of experience in the field of histocompatibility and immunogenetics. This individual shall have served on the Board of Directors for a minimum of two years.

Vice-President of Operations Candidate: _____

Board Member (2 Non-doctoral & 1 Doctoral) - Three-year term – Board members function as part of the governing body responsible for accomplishing the objectives of the Society. The Board members' responsibilities include direct oversight of their assigned committee(s) and they shall regularly report to the Board of Directors on activities undertaken by the committees. Board members shall have a minimum of three years' experience in the field of histocompatibility and immunogenetics. In addition, all candidates for Board membership must have demonstrated at least three years of commitment to forwarding the Society's strategic goals.
