QUESTION: How do I become a laboratory inspector?

ANSWER: The very first step to becoming an ASHI laboratory inspector is to attend a training workshop – this must be a full day workshop, and those are offered only once every other year, at the same time as the ASHI Annual Meetings in the fall. The good news is, 2024 happens to be a year where a full day workshop will be offered – in conjunction with ASHI's 50th Annual Meeting this October 2024 in Anaheim, CA.

Inspectors must be active members of ASHI and employed at an ASHI accredited laboratory. You will participate in 2 training inspections before you can go out solo – and expected to attend a training workshop (just a half day session) at least once every 2 years.
