## **Executive Summary**

Since 1982, tips coming in over the Crime Stoppers hotline in Tarrant County have resulted in excess of **\$3,231,750** in rewards being paid to anonymous tipsters. These tips resulted in the recovery of over **\$38,456,870** worth of stolen property and narcotics, **14,994** law breaking individuals being arrested, and **35,253** cases being cleared.

The Crime Stoppers of Tarrant County Program has two operational divisions. Collectively, in 2020 these divisions paid **\$84,050** in rewards. These rewards helped effect the recovery of **\$1,438,673** in stolen property and narcotics, the arrest of **228** individuals, and the clearing of **607** cases.

### **The Community Program – 2020**

Countywide, Crime Stoppers assisted in the recovery of stolen property and narcotics valued at **\$1,433,559**. In addition, **208** arrests were made, **477** cases were cleared, and **\$77,750** in rewards was paid in 2020.

### **The Campus Program - 2020**

Rewards for the Campus Crime Stoppers Program totaled **\$6,300**, with **\$5,114** in stolen property and narcotics being recovered, **20** individuals arrested, **73** administratively disciplined, and **130** cases cleared on Tarrant County elementary, middle, and high school campuses.

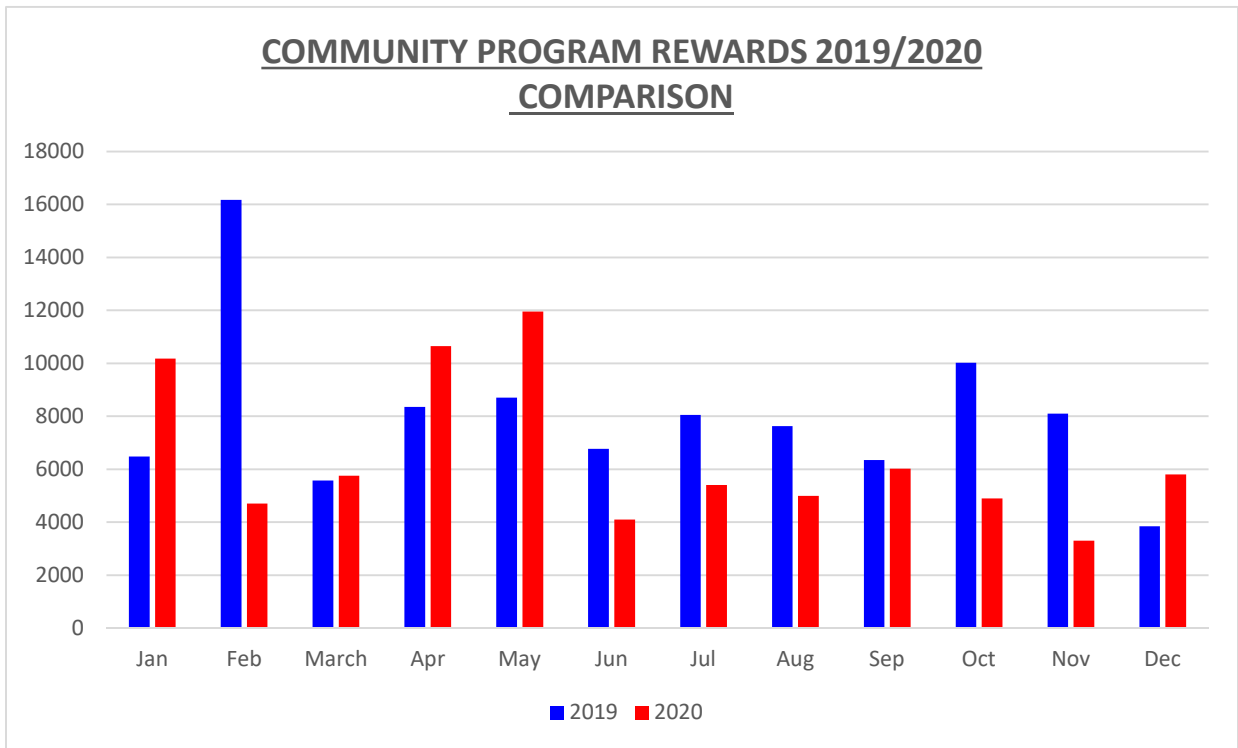

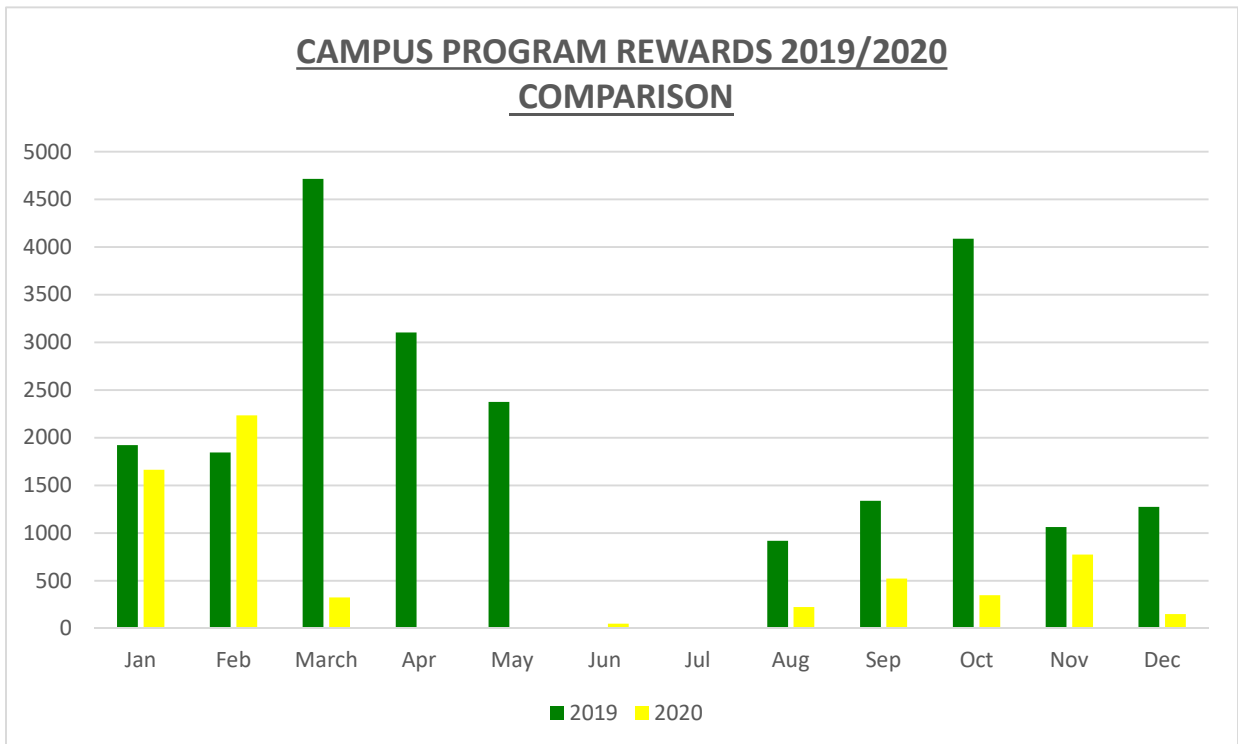
