This policy applies to all information received by the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation, both online and offline, any electronic, written, or oral communications.

Personal Information

Your right to privacy is very important to us. We recognize that providing the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation with your personal information is an act of trust. When you visit the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation online, you remain anonymous, as we do not require registration to view our website or access information.

We may occasionally ask for your feedback via surveys or other communications to better understand your interests and needs. We will also request information through online forms used to register for a foundation event. The Foundation does not share or make public any personal information gathered through our website. The Foundation does not collect information from minors under age 13.

E-mail Privacy:

The website is owned and operated by the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation. Our intention is to inform and educate visitors about our work as a grantmaker, community resource and philanthropic partner to local individuals, families, corporations, nonprofits and other grantseekers. The Greater Green Bay Community Foundation is committed to honoring the privacy of all those we work with, including visitors to our website and subscribers to our electronic newsletters.

If you are a Greater Green Bay Community Foundation fund holder and you use our online system, you provide personal information to authenticate your identity. That information is only used on this site and is not distributed or sold to any other party or site. Our secure system for donors is encrypted with TLS1.2, TLS1.1 or TLS1.0, using 256 or 128 bit Advanced Encryption Standard (AES) to provide security and privacy when you access fund information, initiate online fund transactions or send secure messages.

Third Party Sites

Throughout our website(s), we offer links to third party sites. Since we do not control those websites, we encourage you to review their privacy policies as well.

Communications

If at any time you wish to stop receiving the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation's electronic newsletters or other communications, or to be removed from our email list, you may unsubscribe from that list as explained in each message. The Greater Green Bay Community Foundation will not give your email addresses to other organizations; however, we may

occasionally send you mailings regarding events, products or services by reputable third parties if we think they may be of interest to you. In such circumstances, we do not provide the organization with your information, but send the mailing ourselves.

Board Meeting Confidentiality and Privacy:

In order to encourage and foster open and candid discussion at Board of Directors and committee meetings, we believe confidentiality must be maintained. Each director and staff member shall keep confidential any and all information relating to discussions at its meetings unless compelled by legal process to disclose such information, or as otherwise agreed by the Board. While Board members are free to discuss the result of Board action items, disclosing any information concerning the discussion of such items during the Board meeting is prohibited. Board members acknowledge that any violation of this policy could cause harm to the Foundation and frustrate Board deliberations. Therefore, any Board member who violates this policy shall be subject to termination of his/her Board position.
