What is International Ministry?

- Helping them get acclimated to life in the U.S..
- Offering friendship with Americans that genuinely love and care for them,
- Intentionally sharing Jesus in ways they understand and can relate to.
- Currently we offer 15 different in person classes to help our international friends connect.
- We offer 5 different online class options for those not living in Michigan.
- It is not necessary for our team members to speak the languages of our international friends because when they show Jesus' love, it transcends all language barriers.

English Levels for Classes

Level 1—Speaking in English our friends cannot make basic, complete sentences. Listening in English our friends can only understand a few words here and there.

Level 2—Speaking our friends can make a simple, basic sentence. Listening our friends can understand adjectives and descriptions.

Level 3—Speaking our friends can have a simple conversation with Americans. Listening our friends can understand the main ideas and concepts of a conversation.

Level 4—Speaking our friends can express opinions and feelings. Listening our friends can understand and participate in conversations about others opinions and feelings.

Level 5—Speaking and Listening our friends can participate in discussions on most topics and are comfortable in "English only" situations.
