Safety Plan for Returning to In-Person Worship at SSUMC During the COVID-19 Pandemic

- SSUMC will hold two in-person services on Sunday mornings in the Fellowship Hall at 9:01 a.m. and in the Sanctuary at 11 a.m. starting March 7, 2021.
- Worship services will continue to be available online for those not wishing to attend in-person services. Streaming continues via Facebook, YouTube, and SSUMC website.
- In the Sanctuary, every other pew will be blocked off to promote safe spacing. In the Fellowship Hall, household groups must maintain 6 feet of social distance from other household groups.
- Those who live in the same household should sit together, including youth and children.
- No Nursery or Preschool will be available but Godly Play (for age 4 through 5th graders) will meet during both worship services.
- No offerings will be taken during worship services; an offering box is available in the Narthex.
- There will be no printed bulletins; an order of worship can be accessed online.
- During services, congregational singing will not be permitted.
- No food or drinks will be served.
- Attendance will be recorded along with contact information for attendees in the event of a possible exposure.
- Participants will be asked to use hand sanitizer when entering and exiting the building and worship areas.
- MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED. Everyone must keep masks on throughout the service - no exceptions. Participants are asked to bring their own mask (extra masks available if needed).
- Directional signs will be posted for entering and leaving worship areas and stairwells.
- The elevator will be reserved for those whose mobility limits the use of stairs. Only one household group on the elevator at a time.
- Worship spaces will be cleaned following services before the next use of the space.
- Restrooms may only be occupied by one worshiper at a time.
- Interior doors will remain open to limit the need to touch door knobs.
- Upon conclusion of services, worshipers will be directed out by ushers to maintain social distancing.
