Attend A Community Event

Every year, Denver Public Schools goes through a curriculum review and adoption process. We want to make sure that our students have high-quality, up-to-date materials for our students while still holding ourselves accountable for being fiscally responsible.

We have asked several curriculum providers to provide options for a committee of teachers to review based on our quality standards. We also hold a community event to gather input on these options.

Why are we adopting new curriculum?

Our current resources for middle school social studies and high school mathematics are not aligned to the Common Core State Standards and the Colorado Academic Standards for Social Studies. We need to be sure that our teachers are equipped with high quality resources to prepare our students for college and career readiness. We are adopting curriculum for high school math as well as middle school social studies. We should have a decision in December of 2016.
