  - On appeal from the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, Criminal Division
  - Appellant asserts the conviction for possession of a controlled substance violates the Due Process Clauses of the Fourteenth Amendment and the Florida Constitution
- Aviation Performance Solutions, LLC v. Hinshaw & Culbertson, Dickinson Wright, Timothy I McCulloch, No. 2024-0504
  - On appeal from the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit
  - Appeal of an order granting summary judgment. Presents questions involving the accrual of a legal malpractice claim.
- SFR Services, LLC, Canterbury Place Homeowners Association v. Certain Underwriters at Lloyd's London, 2024-0362
  - On appeal from the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit
  - The underlying matter involves a property insurance claim.
  - Appeal of final order entering summary judgment and finding in favor of the insurance company that the insured failed to give prompt notice of the loss.

  - On appeal from the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit
  - Appeal of post-verdict order granting motion to set aside a jury verdict awarding damages, which also granted motions for a post-trial directed verdict and new trial.
- Aimee L. Goldstone, Richard Goldston v. Gloria Auston Family Trust Agreement, No. 2023-2426
  - On appeal from 17th Judicial Circuit
  - Appeal of final judgment in which the trial court ordered rescission of a quitclaim deed.
