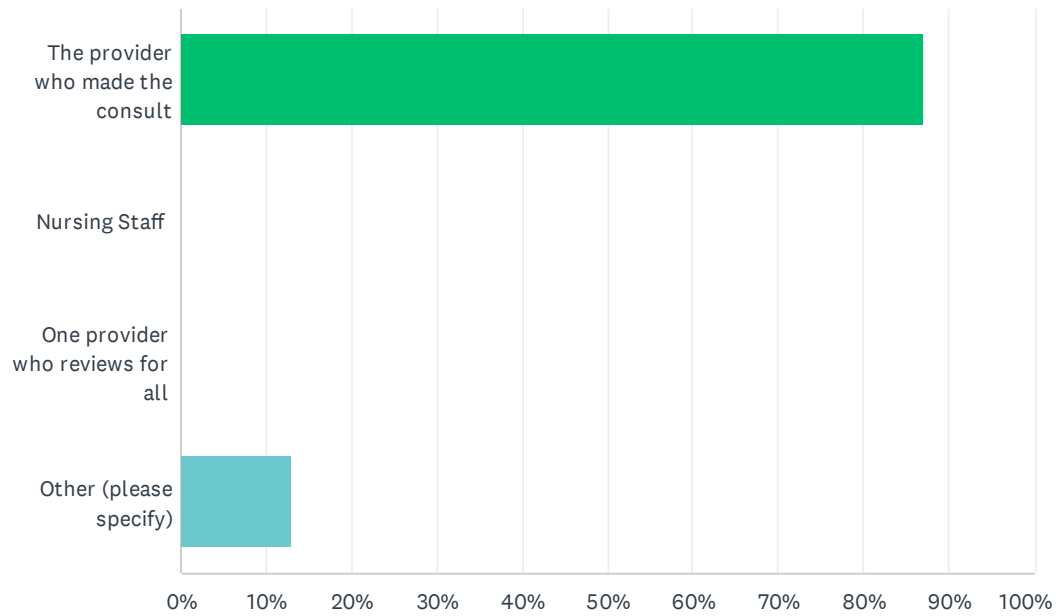


Q1 Who reviews the consult notes from a specialist referral?

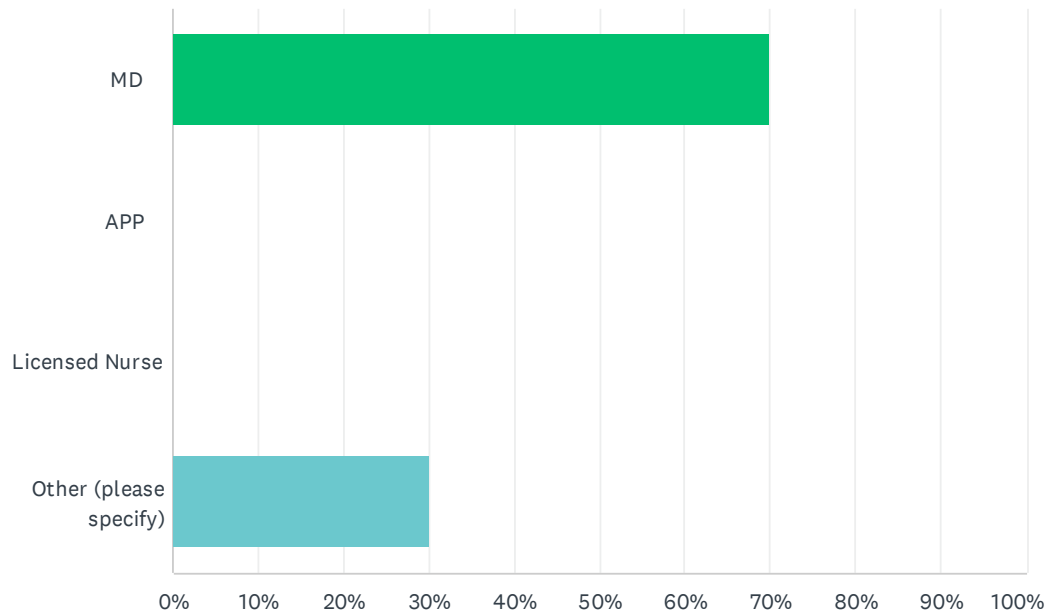

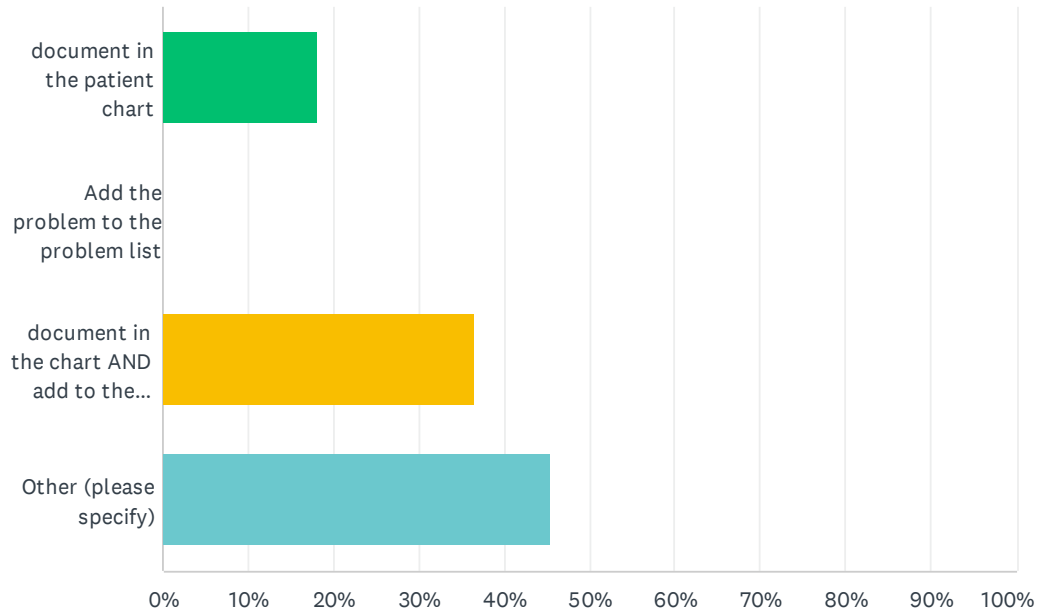
