The following guidelines need to be followed when preparing for talent show auditions:

- 1. Students in grades K-4 have approximately a 3 minute time limit.
- 2. Students in grades 5-8 have approximately a 4 minute time limit.
- 3. Acts involving students in various grades have approximately a 4 minute time limit.
- 4. All vocal acts are required to have live or karaoke accompaniment. Singing with a a pre-recorded vocalist is not acceptable and the act will be disqualified at auditions.
- 5. Parents, grandparents, older or younger sibling(s) may participate.
- 6. Students may create an act with any other student(s) in school. Groups may be any size as long as they will work in Msgr. Lammers Gym.
- 7. All music should be listened to carefully before chosen. Acts that choose to include songs containing foul language and/or lyrics that suggest abuse, violence, drugs, alcohol, sexuality or adultery, etc. will be disqualified from auditions.
- 8. Pet acts are permitted.
- 9. All clothing for the talent show should be appropriate for school. All guidelines for dress down days and dress up days apply. Any exceptions should be approved by Mrs. Garner.
- 10. Auditions will need to be recorded on a mobile device and uploaded to the Talent Show Classroom on Google at https://classroom.google.com/c/MTk0MTE2MDI2MjYz?cjc=6scjiws
 The access code is 6scjiws. Once you are in the classroom, you will see instructions on how to upload your audition video. The audition recording sent to the Google Classroom is to be the actual act to be performed and also include the outfit being worn during the live performance. Recordings will need to be submitted to the Google Classroom by March 25, 2022. Auditions can also be sent by email to Mrs. Garner (sgarner@stpeterjc.org), memory stick, or DVD. The Talent Show will be held on Tuesday April 5th at 12:45. The talent show will be recorded.
