BLACK HAWK: 1767-1838, War chief.

PONTIAC: 1720-1769, Ottawa war chief.

CHIEF JOSEPH: 1840-1904, Chief of the Nez Perce tribe.

RED CLOUD: 1822-1909, Lakota Sioux warrior.

COCHISE: 1815-1874, Apache leader.

SACAJAWEA: 1788-1812, Explorer, interpreter, and guide.

CRAZY HORSE: 1840-1877, Sioux Indian war chief.

SEQUOYAH: 1767-1843, Invented the Cherokee alphabet.

GERONIMO: 1829-1909, Apache leader.

SITTING BULL: 1831-1890, Chief of the Lakota Sioux Indians. Won the Battle at Little Bighorn.

HIAWATHA: c. 1450, Legendary chief of the Onondaga remembered in a poem by Henry Wadsworth Longfellow.

SQUANTO: 1581-1622, Interpreter, teacher. Instrumental in the Pilgrims' survival.

JIM THORPE: 1888-1953, Olympic athlete and football player.

TECUMSEH: 1768-1813, Shawnee leader. Fought in the war of 1812.

MARIA TALLCHIEF: 1925-2013, Ballerina.

WILL ROGERS: 1879-1935, Entertainer.

POCAHONTAS: 1595-1617, Powhatan princess.
