UOV OPP CHARGE DRIVER WITH IMPAIRED MONDAY

(PEMBROKE, ON) – The Upper Ottawa Valley (UOV) detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) has charged a driver following a single vehicle collision on Prince Street in the City of Pembroke.

The collision occurred shortly before 5:30 p.m. on January 30, 2023. The driver was arrested at the scene and transported to the detachment for further testing. There were no injuries as a result of the collision.

Charlotte SARAZIN, 37 years old, of Pembroke was charged with impaired operation.

The accused had their driver's licence suspended for 90 days and the vehicle was towed and impounded for seven days. The accused was released to appear at the Ontario Court of Justice in Pembroke on March 7, 2023.
