## Apprenticeship Update

The CCAI team is excited to begin another semester! This month, they are submitting an application for a new apprenticeship in Forestry & Natural Resources. Notification of intent to award will be released on February 15, 2019.

The first cohort of Hospitality apprentices have completed the program and most of them have already been promoted into supervisory roles! The second cohort is entering their last semester, the third cohort has two semesters left, and the first cohort of Jackson Rancheria apprentices successfully completed their first semester and is moving full steam ahead! A sustainability plan with Black Oak Casino and Evergreen/Rush Creek Lodge is currently underway.

A fourth cohort of Child Development apprentices enrolled in the program and will start classes January 14, 2019, bringing the total number of registered Child Development apprentices to 43! The CCAI team is busy supporting them in their classes, their permit applications, and will begin working to secure a sustainability plan with local employers once the grant-funded slots are full.





