GM's Bay City Plant Drives Local Impact with \$60,000 in Community Impact Grants to Three Area Nonprofits

General Motors Bay City Operations presented the latest installment of its Community Impact Grants (CIG) to three area nonprofits. The \$60,000 in grants this year target local nonprofits aimed at supporting STEM education and Road Safety throughout the community.

The recipients of the 2024 Bay City-area grants include:

- Delta College Foundation to support STEM education in area schools that provide information about the vast opportunities available in STEM careers.
- United Way of Bay County to support STEM preparedness for students.
