



What is MAGIC?

The Multi Affiliate Global Issues Competition (MAGIC) provides students with the opportunity to work with students from other areas to complete a GIPS booklet. Students register individually, and then will be assigned to a team of 3-4 students representing different areas. MAGIC gives students the chance to use their FPS knowledge as a foundation to collaborate with each other in response to a Future Scene.

MAGIC teams will be created in an effort to balance the difficulty of cross-time zone collaboration, as well as the excitement and opportunity to work with new teammates from different backgrounds and areas. Teams are designed with either 3 or 4 students on them. Ideally, students will not be assigned to teams with students from their schools or Affiliates, though this may be the case for a handful of students.

All times noted are EDT. Please consider what your local time will be for all events. It is the participants' responsibility to attend and participate accordingly.

Teams will need to identify a time for interacting during the practice session, as well as establishing a time for the students to complete their competitive booklet. Please be mindful of time zones. **The decision of when to practice and compete online is at the sole discretion of the participants.** Miscommunications or misunderstandings about the planned "meeting time" will not be grounds for reassigning team members, or adjusting competition timers. Please coordinate in advance.

Competition Times

The competition will open on the FPSOnline system at noon Friday August 27 and close at 3pm Saturday August 28. Please indicate your first and second choice for completing your booklet. Competition time preference will be used to make team assignments. The precise time that a team completes their booklet will be of their choice.

- A. Friday August 27 noon-3pm
- B. Friday August 27 5pm -8pm
- C. Friday August 27 9pm-midnight
- D. Saturday August 28 11am-2pm

MAGIC booklets contain 8 challenges and 8 solutions to be completed within a 2 hour timeframe. The 2-hour competition begins when the first member of the team clicks "go to virtual booklet". Failure to establish communication prior to beginning the competition, miscommunications, or misunderstandings about beginning the booklet as a team, will not be grounds for reassigning team members, or adjusting competition timers. Please coordinate in advance.

Publication Release/Statement of Authenticity

All competitors are required to submit a completed Publication Release/Statement of Authenticity form prior to the MAGIC event. The link to this electronic form will be sent to the competition contact email, after MAGIC registration closes.
