FAQS

Q: What should we wear?

A: The Hive is cocktail casual. Gentlemen, you can leave the tie at home - be dapper but comfortable. Ladies, skirts, dresses, nice jeans and a blouse are all acceptable. Most of the event will be held outside on the gorgeous Toll House courtyard patio. Please bring a mask depending on your comfort level.

Q: Should we arrive at 6pm or be fashionably late?

A: The Hive begins promptly at 6pm with sign-ups for group parties in the fall, wine wall and silent auction. There's a "buy it now" feature for silent auction items so we anticipate items selling fast! The sign-up parties also sell out fast, so arrive on time and don't miss out.

Q: Where do we park?

A: There is ample parking at the Toll House. There is a lot outside the main entrance (in the back), garage parking under the Toll House, and limited street parking in front of the hotel on South Santa Cruz. If you park on the Toll House property, in order to exit, you will need a key card from the hotel's front desk. We highly recommend that guests use Uber/Lyft or other car services. Have fun and be responsible.

Q: What about food and drinks?

A: There will be passed hors d'oeuvres, a taco station and a slider station. For drinks, a welcome cocktail will be hosted as well as some wine on the tables during the Live Auction. There will be two no host credit card bars at the event so please don't forget your wallets.

Q: What time should we tell the sitter we will be home?

A: The event closes at 10:30pm. This includes dancing to a live band, "Hard Pop," featuring local dads after the live auction ends at 9pm.

Q: So many fun sign-up parties! Can we sign our friends up too?

A: Attendees have first dibs on the sign-up parties. Spots still available when The Hive ends will be offered to the rest of the community, just look for the Beehive announcements after the Hive.

Q: How can we spend money at the event to support the school?

A: We have something for everyone, including:
