

SWARM FAQS

- **What is the Swarm?** The Swarm is our school wide field games and picnic day.
- **How are the Swarm teams created?** All students, kinder through 5th, are placed by our staff on mixed grade teams.
- **Who are the team captains?** Fifth graders take on the leadership role of being team captains. They guide their teams through the game stations and are responsible for their team.
- **Are there team uniforms for the Swarm?** Yes! All students will be given a Swarm t-shirt courtesy of our Community Sponsors. Each grade level has a different color Swarm shirt. Students will get their shirts the day of the Swarm.
- **Does my child need anything else for the Swarm?** All of our Swarm games are outside on the field and blacktop so students should wear sunscreen and bring a hat if they would like.
- **Can parents come to watch the Swarm?** Parent spectators are not allowed from 8:30am to 11:30am. The only parents on campus will be those who are volunteering at the Swarm.
- **Who can come to the picnic after the Swarm?** At 11:30am, all parents and siblings are welcome to come out to the field for a school wide picnic. Parents must check in at the office first. The picnic will end at 12:25pm when students will return to class until the end of the school day.
- **Is there food available at the Swarm?** Our regular school lunch will be available to all students. In addition, families may preorder lunches from Baja Fresh using this [link](#). Baja Fresh preorders will be available until April 29th. On May 13th, you will pick up your order at the picnic tables at school. You are also welcome to bring your own picnic foods, as well as a picnic blanket to make yourself comfortable.
- **What if I cannot attend the picnic?** You may still preorder a picnic lunch for your child. Your child will still picnic on the field and will be welcomed to join other families and friends.
- **How can I volunteer at the Swarm?** We will need volunteers to help with set-up, supervising games, clean up, and food distribution.
