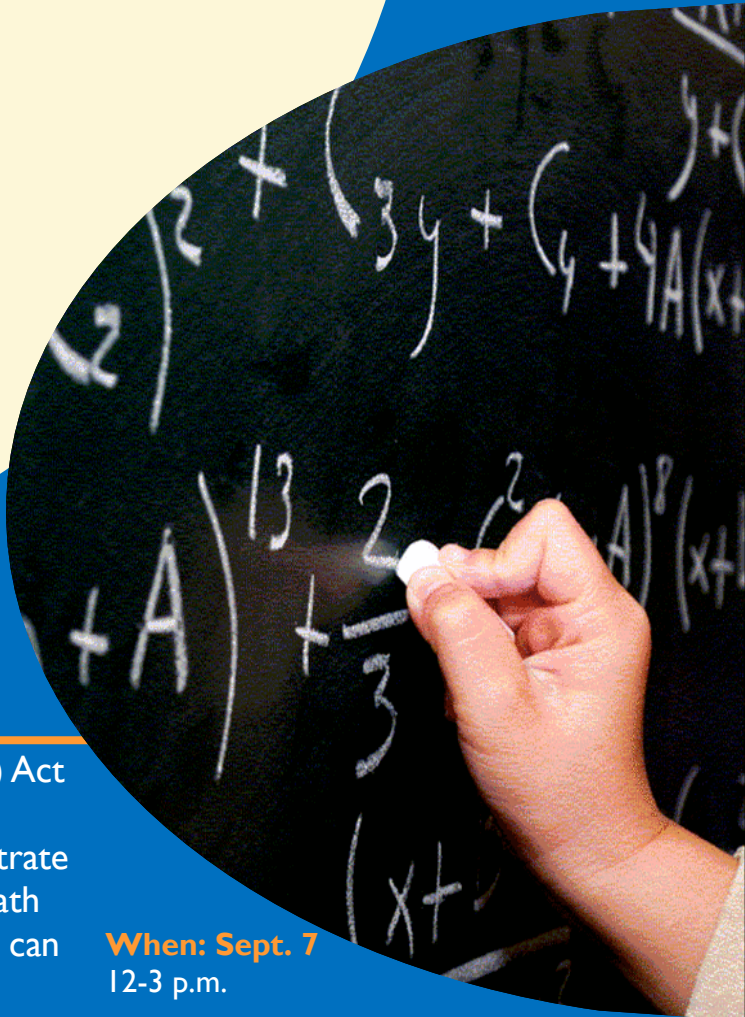




# REGIONAL TRANSITIONAL MATH SUMMIT



The Postsecondary and Workforce Readiness (PWR) Act includes provisions for evaluating students' math proficiency during junior year. Students who demonstrate readiness can decide whether they want to take a math course during senior year. Students who aren't ready can take a transitional math courses in their senior year aligned with the student's career pathway of interest.

This summit will support the co-development of transitional math courses within each community college district of SMHEC. Each high school team will have time to work on their transitional math implementation plan and next steps.
