The Well Receives \$29,000 UTO Grant

The Diocese of Lexington is one of the smaller dioceses in the Episcopal Church. It's easy to think what we do won't make a difference.

Yet one prayer is all that is needed to begin an everwidening circle of thankfulness. The prayers of your parish will extend to other parishes in our Diocese, to all the Dioceses of Province IV, finally uniting in one large worldwide circle of thanksgiving. From those prayers of thanksgiving come thankful offerings which become answered prayers for others in the form of United Thank Offering (UTO) outreach grants.

We in the Diocese of Lexington can attest to the power of thankful hearts. Since 1991, we have received **24 grants** from UTO!



In 2018, The Well,

a mission of Good Shepherd Episcopal Church, Lexington, has been awarded a \$29,000 grant for *Clean Start: A Social Justice Enterprise*. Clean Start, a new initiative of The Well, will offer cleaning services to businesses and residences to provide women with employment opportunities, job experience, and financial autonomy.

The Well, a two-year residential program modeled on Thistle Farms, offers safe housing, case management, and emotional and spiritual support to victims of sex trafficking. However, poverty is at the root of their exploitation, and they cannot move forward without dignified and well-compensated work. Clean Start will provide this work for the women of The Well and for others in the larger community who
