



Notification of Asbestos Re-inspections

In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), in the fall of 1988 we performed inspections of each of our school buildings for asbestos-containing building materials. The inspection findings and asbestos management plans have been on file in each school administrative office since that time.

Previously the EPA required us to perform re-inspections of the asbestos materials every three years. The results of the re-inspections are reviewed and any recommended actions we should take to safely manage each asbestos material in our building are acted upon. New EPA requirements require re-inspections on a six month cycle.

To date there has been no known change in the asbestos-containing building materials of your school since the original inspection. Some asbestos containing materials have been removed, mostly the vinyl floor tile.

All asbestos containing building materials in your school are in good condition to our knowledge and we will continue to manage them in place, as recommended by the accredited management planner.

This notification must be inserted into the management plan in the school's administrative office. Everyone is welcome to view this anytime during normal school hours.
