1. **c)** This prayer invokes the image of the Seraphim cleansing the lips of Isaiah with a burning coal. (Isaiah 6:6-7)
2. **b)** The repetitive nature of a litany allows us to praise and extol the many wonderful attributes of God, Mary, or the saints.
3. **c)** Joseph was the eleventh of Jacob's twelve sons; he was Jacob's favorite. Joseph's brothers, envious of him, sold him into slavery. (Genesis 37-50)
4. **d)** A solemnity is a high-ranking celebration of an event in the life of Jesus, Mary, and the saints, observed throughout the Church. A feast is a secondary importance in the liturgical calendar. Memorials, celebrations of saints of lesser importance, are optional or only observed in specific dioceses.
5. **c)** The name Jesus (*Greek*) or Joshua (*Hebrew*) literally means "God is salvation".
