



### G1 – Office Tower for FNB

- Office Building
  - 26 stories; Core and Shell Construction
    - 22 floors office space
    - 2 levels parking garage
    - 2 level lobby and retail
  - Outdoor plaza and public open space complex
- Compliance requirements with City and Commonwealth (RACP, etc)
- M/WBE, Workforce and reinvestment objectives aligned with the Community Collaboration and Implementation Plan (CCIP)











### M/W Business & Workforce Goals

- 30% Minority and 15% Women business participation (CCIP)
  - ✓ Above and beyond typical inclusion goals per the Community Collaboration and Implementation Plan (CCIP)
- Job Creation/Local Inclusion (CCIP)
  - 20% New Hires Minority Labor Force
    - ✓ Local Residents of the Greater Hill District Community

### M/WBE Goals - How to achieve the goal (CCIP)

M/WBE to be Certified (or in the process of being certified)

- MWBE Direct Subcontract with PJ Dick = 100%
  - Participation goals encouraged beyond 1st Tier and to be flowed down
- JV Teams
  - o >51% = 100%
  - < 50% = the value of the MWBE contracted portion of the JV
    </p>
  - Participation goals encouraged beyond 1st Tier and to be flowed down
- 1<sup>st</sup> Tier Subcontracts under Non-MWBE = 100% paid to MWBE
- Supply/Materials any level = 100% paid to MWBE
- Trucking/Transportation = 100% for services rendered by MWBE

### M/WBE - How to calculate participation (SEA)

M/WBE portion is a calculation on your CCIP plan, NOT another plan

- MWBE Subcontracted work
  - If self-performing <50% of the work, credit only on the amount of the performed work
- Supply/Materials purchased from an MBE or WBE
  - 2% of the amount unless proof of being a broker/supplier is a "full service supplier"
  - 60% of the amount is proof is provided to qualify as a "full service supplier"
    - "Proof" = warehouse or storage capacity, inventory records, agreement with manufacturers, ownership of material handling/delivery equipment, and demonstration of fiscal responsibility on previous sales.












## Next Steps – All Businesses

#### **Steps to Bid**

- 2. Complete the form and hit submit. Please allow us to Publish your contact info and package interest for the greatest exposure.
- 3. Information will be sent to PJ Dick for inclusion in our interested bidders list.
- 4. PJ Dick will reach out, discuss the package of interest to your company, and send out Pre-Qualification requests for those interested to submit a direct Bid.
- 5. Bidding Documents will be issued via email from SmartBid.



# Small Contractor Line of Credit Program

#### Line of Credit and Term

Financing of up to 90% of submitted and approved invoices of \$25,000 - \$100,000 on an annual basis

#### Interest and Fees

There is a \$350 application fee paid annually for each renewal and a 2% administrative fee paid once upon closing. The interest rate is 4% for the loan term, which can be renewed annually

#### Applicants Must:

- Have a proven track record of project completion
- Have a contract for work within one of the Avenues of Hope neighborhoods
- Obtain appropriate permits and business registration from the City of Pittsburgh
- Have between \$50,000 \$500,000 in annual revenue
- Be in good standing with public debt and up to date on taxes
- Undergo inspections at intervals throughout the course of the project
