
Lower Hill Site

Lower Hill is 28 total acres of land distributed over 7 blocks, which are primarily used as parking lots today. Downtown Pittsburgh is located directly west of the site, and to the east lies the Greater Hill District. The site rises in height as you move from southwest to northeast, with a total grade change of 140 feet.






The First Phase of Mixed Use Development







Pathway 1a: Individuals Seeking Direct Employment (Construction)




Pathway 1b: Individuals Seeking Direct Employment (Professional Services)




Pathway 2: Local, MWBE Companies Seeking Procurement Opportunities


