

The Canadian Floor Cleaning & Restoration Association (CFCRA) is a Canadian not-for-profit association that started as an Ontario-based association in 1962 named The Floor Covering Institute of Ontario. The association is also a shareholder of the IICRC. The CFCRA is dedicated to helping its members become the best-trained and informed flooring professionals in the country. Membership is open to any individual or business (regardless of country) and is comprised of manufacturers, distributors, cleaners, restorers, retailers, installers and industry sales representatives.
