**Request for feedback on the proposed regulations for home and community care**

**What's Happening?**

The Ministry of Health is seeking your feedback on the proposed home and community care regulations related to the *Connecting People to Home and Community Care Act, 2020*.

On February 25, 2020, Christine Elliott, Deputy Premier and Minister of Health, introduced Bill 175, *Connecting People to Home and Community Care Act, 2020*. The legislation received Royal Assent on July 8, 2020 and, once proclaimed, will enable Ontario Health Teams (OHTs) and health care providers to deliver better integrated home and community care.

Detailed parameters for the delivery of home and community care will be outlined in regulation and policy. The ministry posted a summary of its proposal to modernize home and community care regulations on the Regulatory Registry from February 25 to April 14, but we understand that some organizations who would have provided feedback were not able to at the time. We are sharing that posting again now (attached) and invite you to provide feedback in writing – although there is no requirement to do so.

**Who is involved?**

All approved and full applicant OHTs and teams in development.
