Up, up and away the balloons go into the New Mexico sky each October! Few spectacles on earth rival the Mass Ascension, as hundreds of hot air balloons lift off from Balloon Fiesta Park to drift in the crisp early-morning high-desert air. This memorable tour also features an evening balloon glow with fireworks, a visit to Ancestral Puebloan Cliff Dwellings at Bandelier National Monument, a ride on the Sandia Peak Aerial Tramway and the culture and history of the Land of Enchantment.

## DAY ONE - Friday, October 5, 2018

### DAY TWO - Saturday, October 6, 2018

# DAY THREE – Sunday, October 7, 2018

Today you travel the **Turquoise Trail Scenic Byway** past former ghost towns to historic **Santa Fe**, the state capital. Once in Santa Fe you can take a guided walking tour of the historic district that ends on the historic Plaza and enjoy a **hosted lunch**. Take a 'flight' on the **Sandia Peak Aerial Tramway** to the top of Sandia Crest. Marvel at the thousands of square miles of breathtaking scenery and panoramic views in all directions. After a **hosted lunch** we continue to **Bandelier National Monument**, best known for its mesas, sheer-walled canyons and the ancestral Pueblo dwellings found among them. Be
