

End Hunger 3.6: An IFPO team will participate in a weekend event on Saturday March 10 at Simon Forum (field house) of Kean University in Madison. Event coordinators are seeking 800 individuals and families to prepare 250,000 pre-packaged meals. These meals - like last year's rice and beans, pesto pasta, mac and cheese, and oatmeal raisin cereal - will go to numerous food pantries and shelters in New Jersey, including IFPO and our food pantry network, MEND.
