From bullying and divorce to abuse and neglect, trauma for a child can be life-altering. Our CARES Trauma Training provides parents, teachers, caregivers, pastors, etc. practical techniques, and insights with a biblical perspective on being more trauma aware. LEADS is our community training. They both give simple tips for dealing with trauma for both children and adults.
