In 2015, we opened our doors to men with our <u>Make It Work for Men</u> program, providing our signature dressing services to men in order to assist them in presenting a positive first impression.

Career Wardrobe strives to break the cycle of poverty by providing support that encourages employment and personal responsibility. 20% of women referred for dressing services go on to voluntarily take advantage of Career Wardrobe's educational programming. The impact on our economy cannot be understated as it is a \$19 million savings for taxpayers in public assistance for benefits alone.
