Campmasters serve on weekends at council camps, are needed to help check in and out packs and troops for weekend camping at LPSR.

Two person teams are assigned

The main job of campmasters is to help visitors have a safe and enjoyable experience. Campmasters arrive in camp Friday evening as soon as possible after work and plan to stay until noon on Sunday or until the last unit checks out. Campmasters stay in the Campmaster Cabin and provide their own food and bedding.

Campmasters provide a camp orientation for each unit as they arrive and tell them how to checkout when ready. They check out any tools and equipment that the unit will need from the ranger. Throughout the weekend, campmasters visit units to see that units are having a positive experience. They may volunteer to teach scouting skills to units as desired. They may also participate in camp improvements projects, as able.
