International Scouting is an important means of advancing the ideal of world brotherhood and providing extraordinary Scouting activities for Scouts and Venturers. Consequently, our council, in cooperation with the National Council leadership, has selected Lynn Brooks as International Representative in order to increase our members' participation in international Scouting.

Initially, Brooks will establish an International Committee to inform council membership of program enrichment opportunities in international Scouting. The committee will then seek Scouts and Venturers willing to pilot participation in international programs such as the upcoming Jamboree On The Air (JOTA)-Jamboree On The Internet (JOTI) on behalf of our council. Finally, the committee will be a resource for our members' participation in the 24th World Scout Jamboree to be held at the Summit Bechtel Scout Reserve in West Virginia from July 22, 2019, to August 2, 2019.

Lynn Brooks brings experience in world travel and Scouting. In 2003-04, the Brooks family traveled to 13 countries in 12 months and visited Scout Troops in Namibia, South Africa, Thailand, New Zealand and Ecuador. In 2007, son, Huyler who later became an Eagle Scout, attended the 100th Anniversary of Scouting at the World Jamboree in England. She currently operates a non-profit, Records without Borders, which provides musical instruments to children in developing countries.
