



Cane Land Distilling Company specializes in estate bottled spirits, made using the freshest Louisiana sugarcane products from their parent company, Alma Plantation & Sugar Mill. [Cane Land Distilling Company, LLC was founded in 2013 by Walter Tharp, whose family owns Alma Plantation & Sugar Mill in Lakeland, Louisiana.]

Truly rare, Cane Land has proprietary control over every facet of the agricultural, refining, and spirit production processes.

Alma Sugar Mill has been growing and milling sugarcane for centuries. Nearly 50,000 acres of sugarcane are processed each year. In 2016, Alma produced almost 400 million pounds of sugar and seven million gallons of molasses.

One of the most unique aspects of Cane Land is not their virtual unlimited scalability in traditional rum production, but their ability to ferment large quantities of sugarcane juice during the three-month harvest season, vetting them to be the largest rhum agricole producer in the continental United States.

Head Distiller and Rummy Jonny Ver Planck voiced his eagerness about the venture stating, "I'm excited to be able to work with what I feel is the cleanest and freshest cane juice available anywhere."

Cane Land currently sells three rums, a sugarcane vodka, and a whisky in Louisiana, and can also be purchased online through Sunset Corners.
