

Three-day Distilling with Advanced Techniques and Technologies Workshop

Course Overview:

New World Distillery, in Eden, UT, will be hosting a second hands-on, interactive course with Craft Distillers Chris and Ashley Cross, and Odin of iStill.

*You will be trained in several theories of distilling and how you can apply them to make better tasting spirits.

*Together, with Odin of **iStill**, we'll pack a ton of classroom instruction and production floor application into three full days.

*We will also take a "field trip" to a local craft brewery to discuss mashing for brewing as compared to distilling.

*Colleen Moore and Scott Moore, M. Arch, from **Dalkita Construction** will lead an engaging 3-hour course covering building and fire code considerations every distillery must reconcile during design and construction. The course will cover dealing with facility site selection, compliance with various codes and general tips to get a distillery up and running with the blessing of BOTH the building department and the fire department of the local jurisdiction.

*Mark Coombs from Anton Parr will run a session on proofing spirits.

*At the end of the course, you will have learned how to influence the taste profile of the spirits you want to make; you will have learned about cuts, and you will learn how mashing and fermenting can be tweaked in such a way that they support the taste-rich flavor profile that will define your craft spirit.
