New Awards Announced for Several Myer Farm Distillers Spirits

Ovid, N.Y., —Today, American Distilling Institute recognized Myer Farm Distillers, in Ovid, N.Y., with eight medals in its 2018 Judging of Craft Spirits competition. Earlier this month, Myer Farm earned five medals from the American Craft Spirits Association's 2018 Annual Competition.

“Receiving 13 awards from two different national craft spirits competitions within weeks of each other is both a thrill and an honor for us,” says President and Master Distiller, Joe Myer, adding, “The support we receive from local spirit lovers has been terrific, so we’re happy to see that we’re continuing to produce some of the best spirits in the country right here in New York.”

At the American Distilling Institute competition, in Portland, Oregon, Myer Farm Distillers earned Silver medals for: John Myer New York Straight Rye Whiskey-Single Barrel, John Myer New York Straight Four Grain Whiskey-Single Barrel, and John Myer New York Straight Corn Whiskey. Bronze medals were awarded to: Myer Farm Gin, Cayuga Gold Barrel Gin, Myer Farm Lavender Vodka, John Myer New York Straight Bourbon Whiskey-Single Barrel, and John Myer New York Straight Wheat Whiskey-Single Barrel.

The distillery received five Bronze medals from American Craft Spirits Association's 2018 Annual Competition, announced March 5, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Spirits recognized were: John Myer New York Straight Bourbon Whiskey-Single Barrel, John Myer Rye Whiskey, John Myer Bourbon Whiskey, John Myer New York Straight Four Grain Whiskey-Single Barrel, John Myer New York Straight Corn Whiskey.

Currently in its sixth year of production, Myer Farm Distillers is a New York State Farm Distillery co-owned by Myer, his brother and the company's vice president John, and John's son Bennett. Myer Farm Distillers craft distills a range of award-winning spirits using

International Certification Services (ICS) certified organic grain, grown on site at Myer Farm, of which John Myer is proprietor. It is one of the largest and oldest operating organic farms in the Northeast.

Available on-site at the tasting room and at many local and regional outlets, Myer Farm Distillers currently offers 22 different spirits, including Vodka, Flavored Vodkas, Gin, aged Gin, Corn Whiskey, Bourbon, Rye, Wheat, and Four Grain Whiskeys, straight single-barrel whiskeys, specialty spirits, and naturally flavored whiskeys.
