


Esaias Valles still sits on the apprentice sponsorship waitlist, despite having a year of ABC NorCal electrical education and certifications.

These students have learned roping 101, blueprint reading, device boxes, 3-way switches and more. We have a mix of participants looking to be sponsored into the apprenticeship program and can work as Electrical Trainee's in the field.
