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WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT



ABC NorCal & CERF (Community Economic Relief Fund) met to discuss finalized CERF regions and labor workforce efforts in that area. CERF funds are from the American Rescue Plan and must be encumbered by June 30, 2024. ABC NorCal will be working to bring education and apprenticeship to the forefront in partnership with CERF recipients.

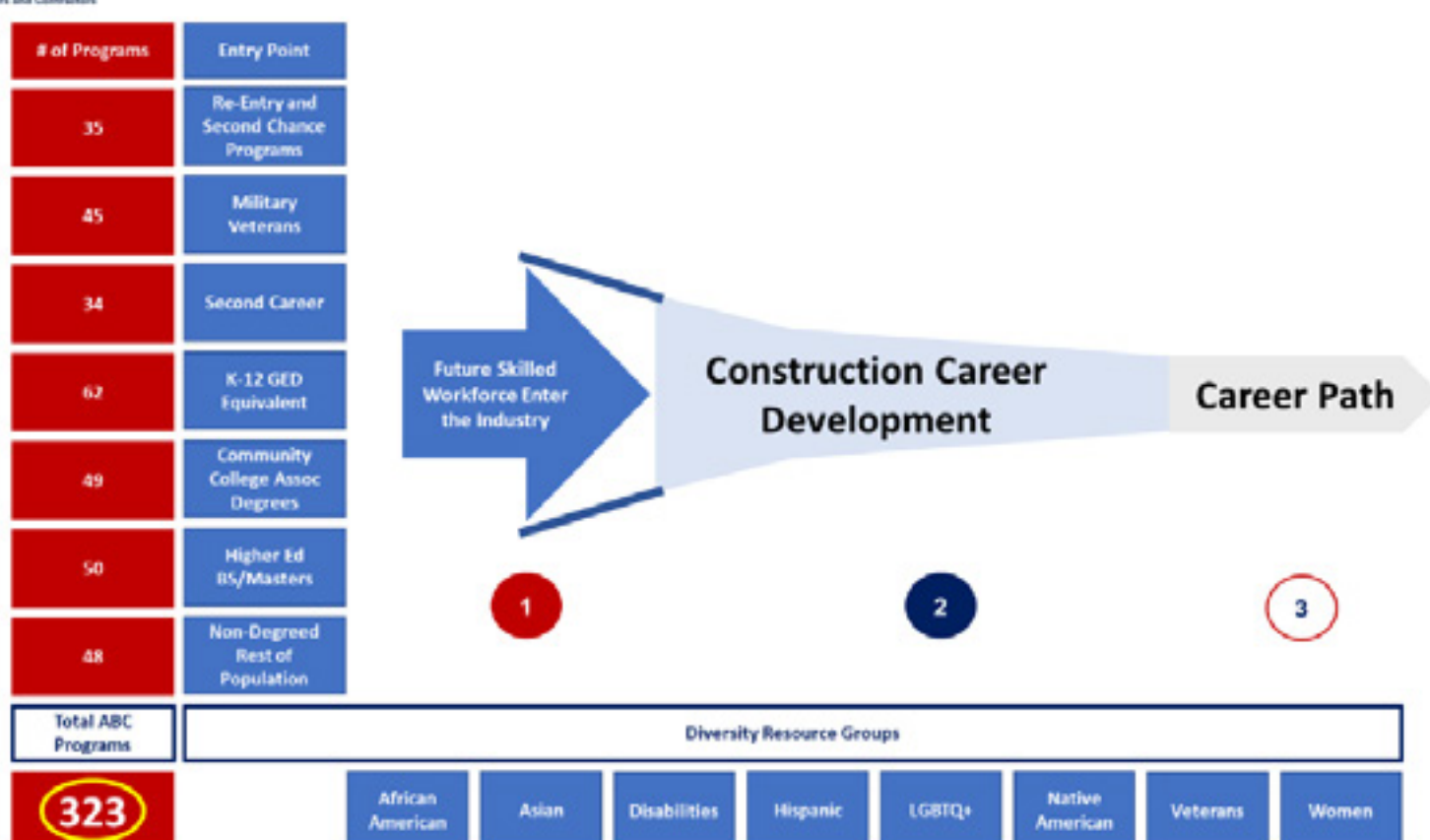


Community Partnership for Families of San Joaquin
