What's New

Adults 55+

Effective Friday, April 30, adults 55 years of age and over are eligible to book a vaccine appointment at all public health and hospital clinic locations. A pilot will also launch through [select pharmacy locations in hot spot communities](#) to administer the Pfizer vaccine to individuals aged 55 and over. Eight stores in Peel will participate in this pilot, with each location receiving approximately 150 doses per week.
