Construction Work: On or after **June 17th to December 31st, 2020**

The rehabilitation of Brookhurst Road Bridge will commence within the next few weeks. Work on the bridge includes the widening of the sidewalk and maintenance repair to extend the life of the bridge.

COVID-19 Coronavirus Update: Taking Steps to Stop the Spread

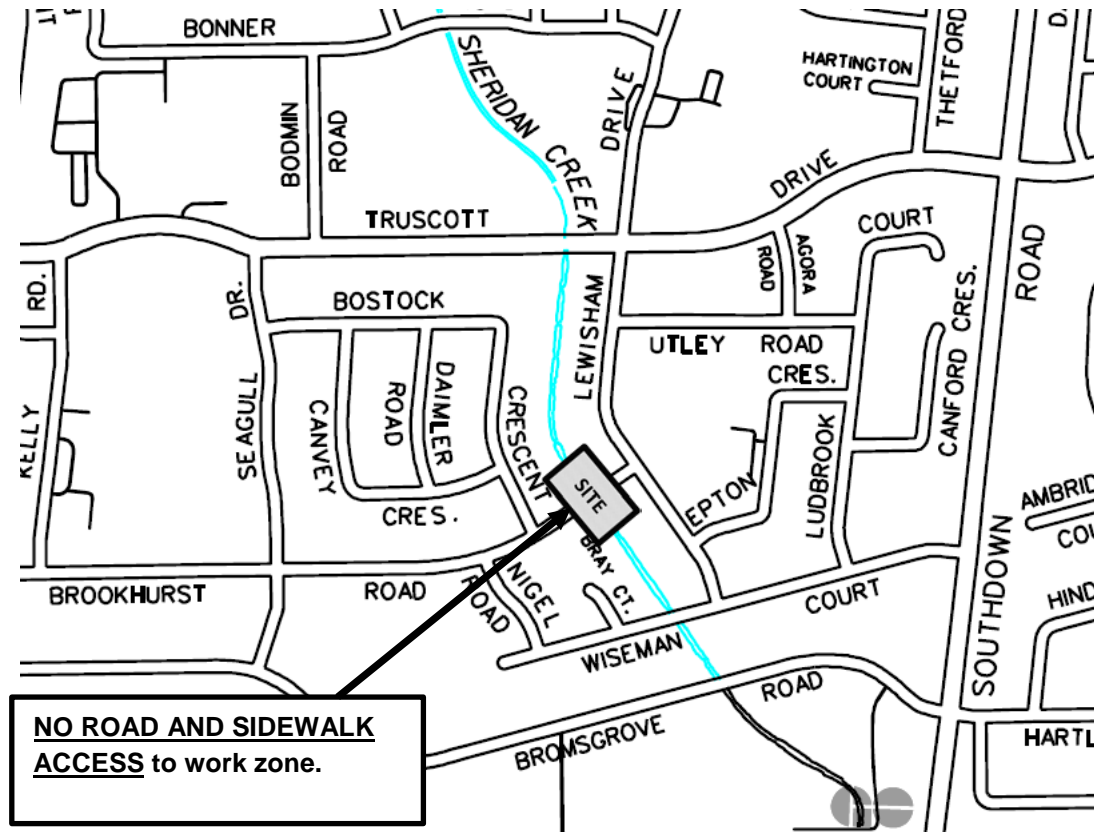
The construction project that will be taking place on your street is considered an essential service under the recently enacted Ontario Regulation 82/20 because it involves the repair and maintenance of the City's roads. The City's Contractor is required to carry out all construction activities in accordance with all applicable laws, including the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* (and regulations) and the advice, recommendations and instructions of public health officials. These recommendations include training of all employees, contractors and trades on COVID-19 policies, maintaining physical distancing of 2 metres, providing on-site sanitation, and tracking and monitoring of workers and site visitors. The City will closely monitor and work with the Contractor to ensure complete adherence to all COVID-19 regulations and policies. The Province has also advised that they will be increasing the number of Ministry of Labour Inspectors to ensure that essential businesses are complying with the health and safety requirements.
