Youth 12+ Peel Region

Starting Thursday, May 20 at 9 a.m., individuals aged 12 to 15 who live, work, or attend school in Peel will be eligible to book an appointment in Peel Region. Bookings will be accepted for individuals who are 12 years of age or older at the time of vaccination. Pfizer is currently the only vaccine authorized by Health Canada for this age group.

Youth 12+ (as of May 20)	  	Residents of Peel who are 12 to 17 years of age must book an appointment using the Regional website . Any 12 to 15 -year-olds should be accompanied to their appointment by a parent or guardian who can provide verbal consent. If you need help booking, call the Region of Peel COVID-19 Vaccination Line at 905-791-5202 , 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., 7 days a week. Additionally, appointments can also be booked at hospital-run clinics in Peel , mobile school clinics and select pop-up clinics.
