

# Getting a Vaccine in Peel Region

## What’s New

### Youth 12+ Peel Region







Starting Thursday, May 20 at 9 a.m., individuals aged 12 to 15 who live, work, or attend school in Peel will be eligible to book an appointment in Peel Region. Bookings will be accepted for individuals who are 12 years of age or older at the time of vaccination. Pfizer is currently the only vaccine authorized by Health Canada for this age group.
