DESIGN VALUES

- Create a mural for an outdoor school environment that reflects and celebrates the community with themes of cultural vibrancy, equity, and diversity
- Bring diverse communities together through the storytelling of Prince George's Proud stories (developed during community workshops)
- Provide a welcoming landscape to all

ROLE OF ARTIST(S)

- Collaborate with PGAHC, the Office of Stakeholder Engagement and Affairs Committee, and community stakeholders on design
- Artwork Fabrication and Installation: The artist(s) will ensure all technical applications to fabricate and install the final artwork design

ARTIST ELIGIBILITY

- The opportunity is open to all artists age 18+
- Must have completed 2-3 murals of similar size in the past 3 years
- Artists from Prince George's County and the DC metropolitan area are strongly encouraged to apply

BUDGET \$10,000

 Project budget includes design fees, materials, cost of installation, and travel/lodging

SELECTION PROCESS & CRITERIA

Prince George's County Arts and Humanities public art staff, Office of Stakeholder Engagement, PGCPS and community stakeholders will review applicants' submitted materials, have an opportunity to ask clarifying questions about applicants' initial ideas and approaches to the project in broad conceptual terms, and develop a ranked list of qualified candidates who will be invited for interviews.


Upon approval, the selected artists or artist teams will be issued a contract. Prince George's Arts and Humanities Council will oversee contract issuance and overall project management.
