The day has arrived, after six months, to come back to the hallways of Fisher Catholic! On Monday 8/24, the Class of 2021 will kick off our reentry week. I want to give you some highlights of what this week will entail:

- We will have a doctor available each morning to do a short presentation to the students and answer any questions they may have.
- The students will report directly to the gym when they arrive at 7:50. There is NO late arrival next week. All students are expected by 7:50am. Normal school uniforms are required.
- The students need to have a mask on when entering the building and that mask will remain on properly throughout the day. We have not received our shipment of FC masks as of yet, so students need to have their own mask. This mask can be plain or patterned but no words or pictures please.
- The students will be expected to distance in the bleachers when they arrive.
- Signs are posted throughout the building and the entryways regarding social distancing, washing of hands, wearing masks and arrows directing them through the one-way hallways.
- The students will receive their updated class schedules/room assignments. This will let them know if they will need to report to one of our auxiliary classrooms due to the size of that particular class. These rooms include the cafeteria, commons, innovation room and alumni gym. They will also be assigned a room to eat lunch.
- All students should bring their own lunch next week if possible.

As many of you are aware, the spring and summer ACT testing dates were cancelled due to COVID. Many of our students were registered for these test dates and could not test. When ACT reopened their testing registration site, the online traffic was 4 times greater than the highest traffic period of the past. They now have a queue system in place and it is difficult to secure a testing date and location for future tests.

ACT has given FC the opportunity to provide the ACT for 10th, 11th and 12th graders on October 6th.

3. The cost to register is \$46 (make checks payable to FCHS, **deadline to submit payment is September 25th**).
