What to Wear/Bring:

1. Boots or water-proof shoes. No open-toe shoes i.e. flip-flops, sandals, crocs.
2. Lightweight t-shirt or scrubs, (scrubs dry quickly after a rainstorm)
3. Durable, baggie pants (keeps the bugs from biting) with pockets and/or belt loops to adhere your radio to you, fanny packs are also a good thing to have.
4. Please dress for the work and keep your attire professional, we have veterinarians, medical doctors, donors, and Board members on property, and we also have tours nearly every afternoon from 4pm – 6pm for our donors.
5. Rain poncho/rain jacket & pants, and a change of clothes if you get wet.
6. Insect repellent.
7. Sunscreen/long sleeves and a hat to keep the sun off your face.
8. Vegan lunch and drinks, if you are staying on site during breaks.
9. Any medications you may need such as aspirin, allergy pills, eye drops, etc.
10. Procedures Manual and notebook.
11. Bring a mask to wear within 6' of the monkeys.
12. A strong back, your compassion, integrity, and a sense of humor is a must!
