

UI IT Security Resources and Services

NASWA recently held a webinar discussing [UIPL 4-21](#) which focuses on security of UI IT systems. During the webinar, NASWA's security team highlighted sections of the UIPL that are important for UI IT systems and described several resources and services that the NASWA team provides to state workforce agencies.

The NASWA security team emphasized the need for states to begin to review the changes to NIST SP 800-53 with [Revision 5](#). To help with this, NASWA will be releasing updated resources such as security guidelines for UI IT modernization and a security preparation checklist, both using the guidance from SP 800-53 Rev 5.

NASWA also introduced a central location for states to access updated security resources on the [UI ITSC website](#). The website features helpful resources to assist states with security as well as fraud prevention and cloud services.
