



NEW VIRTUAL INSTRUCTOR LED TRAINING

You will apply and practice investigative techniques such as:

- Developing an evidence-gathering plan
- Analyzing and weighing different types of evidence
- Documenting evidence
- Interviewing difficult people
- Making determinations based on findings

Our experienced instructors have extensive UI expertise and first-hand knowledge of the investigative process, and you will have the opportunity to interact with other UI staff from across the country.

The course will be offered on a quarterly basis beginning with a section offered March 21-24, 2022, from 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm ET.
