


Oklahoma Implements Online My Reemployment Plan for Job Seekers



On May 6, 2019, the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC) became the first state to successfully implement Phase II of Workforce Connect, commonly referred to as **My Reemployment Plan (MRP)**. My Reemployment Plan is the comprehensive job search guide developed by USDOL in 2015, and announced as [TEN 2-17](#). In 2017, USDOL partnered with NASWA's UI ITSC to develop the paper-based version of the MRP into an interactive online tool, now referred to as the eMRP.

The eMRP is a web-based and mobile friendly tool that guides the jobseeker through the different modules and assists them with useful guides, tips and activities. As 1 of the 7 participating states for the eMRP project, OESC worked with UI ITSC to develop the tools requirements, test functionality, and conduct focus groups. During the focus group sessions, OESC's jobseekers provided valuable first-hand feedback that the project team incorporated directly into the eMRP tool.
